- **\$37,000 Living Allowance** (before taxes, paid on a biweekly basis)
- **\$7,395** Segal Education Award (upon completion of 1,700 hours)*
- Health insurance and childcare assistance for qualifying Fellows, paid to an eligible provider of your choice
- SNAP (Food Stamps) for eligible participants
- Forbearance on existing qualifying student loans and payment of interest accrued during service term
- Professional development training
- Network development with regional and statewide contacts in the community resilience industries
- Connection to a network of CivicSpark and AmeriCorps alumni

AMERICORPS REQUIREMENTS

- Be a citizen, national, or lawful permanent resident of the US*
- Ability to pass a National Service Criminal History background check (NSCHC) prior to service

*At this time, we are unfortunately unable to accept applicants with visas (such as F1 or F2 student visas, J1 or J2 exchange visitor visas, G series visas, etc.), or those with Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) status.

CIVICSPARK REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum of a 2-year AA degree from an accredited college or university
- Commitment to the full term of service (8 months)
- Ability to work in a professional virtual/office setting
- Strong communication (both verbal and written) and teamwork skills
